Conference housing and meals are provided at the hotel for retired pastors. However, they are responsible for their own transportation. Pastors and church workers serving ministries NOT assessed as English District entities, including advisory pastors, spouses, etc. are responsible for all of their own expenses, including meals, hotel room, and transportation.

Registration at the conference begins on Tuesday, April 30 at 2:00 p.m. with **the conference beginning at 3:00 p.m.** The Conference will conclude by 11:30 a.m. on Thursday, May 2.
